
For Poster Presenters (MSSp2025)

Poster Preparation

Panel size: 900 mm x 2,100 mm.

Ensure title, affiliation and presenter's name are clearly indicated at the top of your poster.

Each poster board is labelled with a number. Display your poster at the corresponding location. Posting pins are available at the venue.

Presenter Obligation Time

During the designated Obligation Time, presenters should stay in front of their poster panels to explain their work and answer questions.

For odd number posters: November 5 (Wed.), 1:30 p.m.-2:40 p.m. For even number posters: November 5 (Wed.), 2:50 p.m.-4:00 p.m.

During the designated time, judges for the Best Poster Award will evaluate eligible poster presentations.
